




Population by Age

In the identified area, the current year population is 218,506. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 208,927. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.44% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 222,974 representing a change of 0.41% annually from 2020 to 2025. Currently, the population is 49.5% male and 50.5% female.

Currently, 43.8% of the 66,557 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 47.9%, renter occupied; and 8.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 65,087 housing units in the area - 46.0% owner occupied, 44.6% renter occupied, and 9.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.00%. 
