On-The-Job-Training

This free program provides eligible companies reimbursement for up to 50% of a new hire's wage while they are in training. If your company has specific skills it needs and is willing to hire someone with most of the skills and then provide on-the-job training to teach the rest of the skills, we can help by offsetting part

of their salary for the first 3 months.

CalWORKS Subsidized Employment Programs

The San Bernardino County Workforce Development Department (WDD) has collaborated with the Transitional Assistance Department (TAD) to find employment for the participants of the California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKS) Welfare-to-Work (WTW). As a result of the collaboration two programs are offered. CSEP is California's job readiness and work-experience training program for participants above the age of 25, in the CalWORKS program. CYEP is California's job readiness and work-experience training program for participants, ages 16 through in the CalWorks program.

Veteran Business Outreach Center (VBOC) Program

Veteran Business Outreach Center (VBOC) program is designed to provide entrepreneurial development services such as business training, counseling, and resource partner referrals to transitioning service members, veterans, National Guard & Reserve members, and military spouses interested in starting or growing a small business.
