# Police Continue Crackdown on Narcotics Trafficking

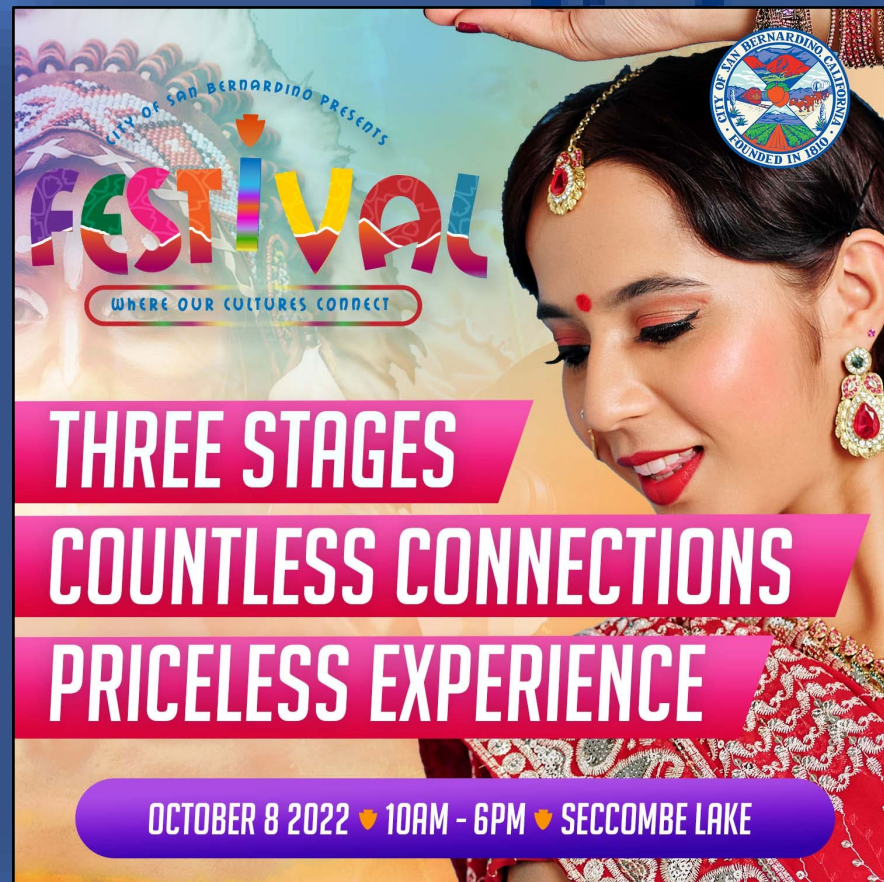
